I am to inform you that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in
Nursing Degree Courses which was held on 10.04.2017 and discussed
various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in
Nursing Degree Courses were approved by the 53rd Meeting of the
Standing Academic Board, which was held on 27.04.2017 and passed in
the 253rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 29.06.2017 which
are detailed below:

POINT NO:1

**THE MODIFICATIONS MADE IN THE CURRICULUM OF NURSING
COURSES BASED ON THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL, NEW DELHI,
RECOMMENDATIONS TO BE INCORPORATED IN THE UNIVERSITY
SYLLABUS AND REGULATIONS.**

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It was resolved to follow the recommendations of the 51st Standing Academic Board with regard to modifications made in the curriculum of Nursing Courses based on the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi recommendations to be incorporated in the University syllabus and Regulations.

The recommendations of 51st Standing Academic Board with regard to Environmental studies as follows :-

2. To follow the existing nomenclature for the subject Obstetrics and Gynaecology as prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council for the courses B.Sc(N), Post Basic (N) and M.Sc(N).

It was further resolved that,

1. No upper Age Limit for admission into Nursing courses.
2. Faculty possessing PG qualification in Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pharmacology and Genetics with the prescribed years of teaching experience shall be the Teachers and Examiners in the concerned subjects.

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3.Nursing Faculty possessing an additional qualification with prescribed years of Teaching Experience in subjects like Nutrition, Psychology, Sociology, English shall be the Teachers as well as Examiners in the concerned subjects..

POINT NO:2

THE OSCE/OSPE PATTERN IN THE SUBJECTS OF B.Sc(N), POST BASIC B.Sc(N) AND M.Sc(N) DEGREE COURSES AND TO REVISE THE TEACHING AND EVALUATION METHODOLOGIES BASED ON THE INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL PRESCRIBED NORMS.

It was resolved to approve the OSCE/OSPE pattern in the subjects of B.Sc(N), Post Basic B.Sc(N) and M.Sc(N) and to submit the same to the University before 30th April and the University can conduct the meeting for standardizing the OSCE/OSPE pattern during November 2017.

This will be implemented from the academic year 2018- 2019 admission onwards.

POINT NO:3

PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS IN NURSING DEGREE COURSE.

It was resolved that it is the responsibility of the Principals of the Nursing colleges to ensure that Students should produce the completed Log book/Practical record book/Midwifery case book at the time of practical examination duly signed by the Principal/Professor/Head of the Department. Hence, the proposal is deferred.

I request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in this regard. I am also to request that a copy may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for information to the students concerned.
