I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in DM/MCh Super Speciality Degree courses held on 01.03.2022 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 61st meeting held on 21.04.2022. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 291st meeting held on 09.06.2022. The Standing Academic Board has resolved that

RESOLUTION NO.1:

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to approve the syllabus and regulations for DM Oncopathology Super Speciality Course with the recommended modifications. However, the syllabus and regulation should be on par with the guidelines of the National Medical Commission.

RESOLUTION NO.2:

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to constitute an Expert Committee to frame the Syllabus and Regulations for D.M. PEDIATRIC HEMATOLOGY ONCOLOGY as per the National Medical Commission guidelines.

RESOLUTION NO.3:

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that submission of thesis is not mandatory for DM Course as per National Medical Commission guidelines.

RESOLUTION NO.4:

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to follow the National Medical Commission guidelines to conduct examination for DM/M.Ch.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that M.Ch Neuro Surgery six year course can be restarted at the State Government institutions by taking appropriate measures by the institutions and Directorate of Medical Education.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to start Post Doctoral Fellowship Programme in Stroke following DM Neurology and Post Doctoral Fellowship Programme in Spine surgery following M.Ch. Neuro Surgery (three years and six years streams).

The Standing Academic Board has resolved not to start the DM (Neuro Critical Care) since the nomenclature is not available in the National Medical Commission.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to include Stroke thrombectomy as a skill set in the curriculum for DM (Neuro) post graduates.
