I am to inform you that the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Homoeopathy Degree courses held on 20.07.2023 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 62<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 17.08.2023. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 297<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.08.2023.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1**

The Standing Academic Board has **resolved** to follow

1) The Notification No.3-90/2022/NCH/HEB/HEB Notice Circular/ 12944 dated 10-02-2023 National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi with regard to Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course – Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (B.H.M.S) Regulations-2022 as notified in the Gazette of India and Published on 7th December 2022. This Regulation shall be applicable from the academic year 2022-2023 onwards..

2) Competency Based Dynamic Curriculum (CBDC) for 1<sup>st</sup> BHMS course as prescribed by the Homoeopathy Education Board, NCH. This Curriculum shall be applicable from the academic year 2022-2023.

3)The Gazette Notification F.No.3-34/2021/NCH/HEB/CC/10758, National Commission for Homoeopathy dated 6th December 2022 for BHMS from National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi from the academic year 2022-2023 with regard to scheme of Examination (TMR) and Question paper pattern.

**RESOLUTION NO: 2**

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that henceforth the Regulations of Break of Study and readmission for all courses of study shall be as follows:

1. Each Candidate shall complete the duration of the Course as prescribed by the respective Councils/Regulatory Bodies.
2. The mandated percentage of attendance and maximum duration to complete the course as per the respective Councils / Regulatory Bodies norms should be complied with. Where there are no Councils, the University norms will prevail.
3. A candidate should obtain Condonation Order from the University, if he/she is absent / continuously on leave for more than three months along with the payment of the requisite fee. The respective institutions should forward the request of the student within two week's time. If delayed, it must be sent with the requisite penal fee.

This rule shall come into effect on approval by the Governing Council. The existing rules will cease to exist henceforth

Further, I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of the Departments of your Institution for information, and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for the information of the students.
