I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Unani Degree courses held on 24.07.2023 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 62nd meeting held on 17.08.2023. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 297th meeting held on 28.08.2023.

RESOLUTION NO. 1:

The Standing Academic Board has **resolved** to follow National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi Expert Committee's Recommendation dated 15-07-2022 with regard to Upper age limit criteria for admission into various ISM Courses (Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha) through NEET as below:

“No candidate shall be admitted to BAMS/BSMS/BUMS Degree programme unless he/she has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31st December of the year of his /her admission in the first year of the programme. **There is no Upper age limit for admission in the BAMS/BSMS/BUMS courses.**”

RESOLUTION NO: 2

The Standing Academic Board has **resolved** to follow the Academic Calendar for the batch 2021-2022 for Ayurveda Under Graduate course issued by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine vide letter dated 24-02-2022 and 08-06-2023.

RESOLUTION NO :3

The Standing Academic Board has **resolved** to follow the Academic Calendar for the batch 2022-2023 for BAMS course issued by National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi vide letter dated 30-01-2023 & 03-02-2023.

RESOLUTION NO.4:

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that henceforth the Regulations of Break of Study and readmission for all courses of study shall be as follows:

1. Each Candidate shall complete the duration of the Course as prescribed by the respective Councils/Regulatory Bodies.
2. The mandated percentage of attendance and maximum duration to complete the course as per the respective Councils / Regulatory Bodies norms should be complied with. Where there are no Councils, the University norms will prevail.
3. A candidate should obtain Condonation Order from the University, if he/she is absent / continuously on leave for more than three months along with the payment of the requisite fee. The respective institutions should forward the request of the student within two week's time. If delayed, it must be sent with the requisite penal fee. This rule shall come into effect on approval by the Governing Council. The existing rules will cease to exist henceforth

RESOLUTION No:5

The Standing Academic Board has **resolved** to follow the Gazette Notification F.No.11-76/2021-BUSS(Unani-UG-Regl) dated 28-02-2022 for B.U.M.S from National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi from the Academic Year 2021-2022 with regard to Scheme of Examination (TMR) and Question Paper pattern.
