I am to inform you that the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Second MBBS Degree course held on 11.07.2023 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 62nd meeting held on 17.08.2023. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 297th meeting held on 28.08.2023.

RESOLUTION No.1

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that marks shall be given for Record in the practical component of Internal Assessment for all Second Year subjects (Pathology, Pharmacology & Microbiology). Formative assessment can be done through Google sheets by the end of every class / lecture.

RESOLUTION No.2

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that henceforth the Regulations of Break of Study and readmission for all courses of study shall be as follows:

- 1. Each Candidate shall complete the duration of the Course as prescribed by the respective Councils/Regulatory Bodies.
- 2. The mandated percentage of attendance and maximum duration to complete the course as per the respective Councils / Regulatory Bodies norms should be complied with. Where there are no Councils, the University norms will prevail.
- 3. A candidate should obtain Condonation Order from the University, if he/she is absent / continuously on leave for more than three months along with the payment of the requisite fee. The respective institutions should forward the request of the student within two week's time. If delayed, it must be sent with the requisite penal fee.

This rule shall come into effect on approval by the Governing Council. The existing rules will cease to exist henceforth.

RESOLUTION No.3:

The Standing Academic has resolved to follow the National Medical Commission's letter dated 10-01-2023, regarding the criteria for the candidates to appear for the Supplementary examination, which states as follows:

- (i) If a candidate is not eligible for main exam, he/she cannot be eligible for Supplementary Exam.
- (ii) If a candidate is eligible for main exam, but does not appear in it, he/she can be allowed to appear in supplementary exam. This will be counted as $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ attempt.
- (iii) With regard to attempt of examination, the Main examination is one attempt and Supplementary examination is an another attempt.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of Departments of your Institution for information and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for the information of the Students.
