

GUIDELINES FOR INTER COLLEGIATE SPORTS MEET

(Common for Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, Nursing , AYUSH and Allied Health Science Courses including Physiotherapy & Occupational Therapy

1. The Vice-Chancellor shall be the Chairman of the University Sports Council.
2. The Organizing Chairman shall be the Dean / Principal of the Host Institution.
3. The Organizing committee shall consist of the Vice- Principal of the host institution, Staff adviser for Students, Students Sports Secretary, Students Fine Arts Secretary and One Senior Professor nominated by the Head of the Organizing Institution.
4. The University Emblem and Institution Sports Meet Symbol shall be prominently displayed in the Letter Head, Banner, Trophy and Certificates prepared for this sports event.
5. Only Students of the affiliated Colleges/ Institutions of this University can participate in the Sports Meet.
6. One responsible faculty member may be deputed to accompany the team to Participate in the Sports Meet.
7. The Heads of the participating Institutions should make necessary travel arrangements for the students. The Host Institutions should arrange for the local hospitality and stay of the Participants.
8. The Host institutions may raise the funds by way of Registration Fees from the participating Colleges or through Sponsors or any other means as per the need.
9. The organizing Chairman should submit the accounts in the prescribed format to the University within 30 days from the concluding day of the Sports Meet event.

10. Preference shall be given to zonal-wise consideration for each discipline independently based on their good track record.

11. The Inter-Collegiate Meet is not an inter-disciplinary Meet (*For example the Dental inter collegiate sports meet should involve the participation of Dental students only even when students of other disciplines are available in the same Host Institution*).

12. This year onwards “another discipline” (Sixth) is being included for sanction of Grant and the zone-wise annual rotation of Host Institutions. This sixth discipline will be a conglomeration of Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Allied Health Sciences.

ANNEXURE

THE CONDITIONS FOR THE SANCTION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE HOST INSTITUTION

1. A copy of the Invitation and Certificate of the Sports event along with a set of Photographs, News Paper cutting, Press release statement and Report of the Sports Meet must be submitted to the University.

2. The University will provide Financial Assistance to a maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) to each of the following six disciplines every Year:

- a) Medical
- b) Dental
- c) Pharmacy
- d) Nursing
- e) AYUSH
- f) Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy
and Allied Health Sciences

80% of the sanctioned amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh) will be released as the first Installment (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) and the remaining 20% (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) will be released as *the second installment only after the submission of Utilization Certificate within the next one month.*

3. Institutions with continuous poor track record will lose their eligibility for Sports Grant:

- (i)Improper Maintenance of procedures to sustain Affiliation*
- (ii)Administrative pitfalls etc.*

4. The Host Institution should submit the Expenditure of Accounts to the University within 30 days following the Sports Meet.

5. The University Grant can never exceed Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) per discipline under any circumstances.

Rules & Regulations

- The application will be called for during the Month of May and June and it should be sent only through the Head of the Institution.

- The College must be instructed to conduct the sports event during the months of October, November and December of every year

- The grant will be sanctioned only to the Dean/Principal of the institution

- The application (two copies) should reach the university on or before 30th of June.

- The Sports event must be conducted as Inter-collegiate Sports meet consisting of various sports/games. Grant will NOT be provided for single sport event. Grant money should NOT be used for traveling allowance / halting allowance etc.,

- The grant released must be utilized only for the following purposes:

- Memento
- Prize
- Printing of Certificates/ Invitations
- Sports materials

- The organizing institution of the sports event must superscribe / inscribe the Emblem / Logo of this university which denotes that the event is conducted utilizing the sports grant from the university.

- The details of previous sports meets (within the past five years) conducted by the applicant institution must be enclosed with the application for sports grant.

- The details of expenditure made during the sports meet must be sent through the Head of the institution with relevant vouchers / bills attested by the same authority along with the receipt and Utilization Certificate within 30 days after the date of the sports meet.

- The decision of the University Sports Council will be final.
