**SUBJECT:** To issue the No Objection Certificate for starting new Ayurved, Unani and Siddha colleges-reg.

Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that CCIM is a statutory body constituted by Govt. of India to prescribe the minimum standards of education in system of medicine i.e. Ayurved, Unani and Siddha systems and matter related thereto.

Further, I am directed to inform that Govt. of India has amended IMCC Act, 1970 by adding section 13A, 13B which stipulate about establishment of new Ayurved, Unani and Siddha college only with the permission of Govt. of India.

In this series the CCIM has prescribed the Regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" copy of relevant part is enclosed herewith as annexure.

There are four main conditions among the other to make the application eligible to apply to the Govt. of India for permission.

- (a) owns or possesses on lease of ninety nine years, a suitable single plot of land, measuring not less than ten acres if the proposal is for admitting up to fifty students, and not less than fifteen acres, if the proposal is for admitting up to one hundred students, and undertake to establish the medical college in the said plot of land;
- (b) has obtained 'No Objection Certificate' in Form- 4 from the concerned State Government for establishing a new medical college at the proposed site;
- (c) has obtained a 'Consent of Affiliation' in Form- 5 for establishing a new medical college from a University established under any Central or State statute;
- (d) owns and manages a hospital in Indian medicines containing not less than one hundred beds with necessary facilities and infrastructure;

Moreover, at the time of certification the State Government should also ensured the availability of minimum built up area of 20,000 sq.ft. for college and 20,000 sq.ft. for hospital separately for starting Ayurved, Unani and Siddha college at initial stage.

It has been observed; several times by CCIM that there is no functional hospital and college building at the time of inspection/surprise check as certified by the State Govt. and university.

Non availability of functional hospital cause the grave/embarrassing situation, therefore, you are requested to ensure the existence of fully functional 100 beded Ayurved, Unani and Siddha hospital, as case may be, with at least minimum average attendance of 100 patients in OPD as well as at least minimum 40% bed occupancy alongwith infrastructure and all required staff as per CCIM norms, while issuing NOC. Moreover, it should also be ensured that hospital and proposed college should be on the land possessed by society for solely purpose for establishment Ayurved, Unani and Siddha colleges. No other institution should be on the proposed site. The copy of required medical and paramedical staff laid down by CCIM is also enclosed.

After issuing the NOC by the State Government and consent by the concerned university If, it is noticed in future by CCIM or any other enquiry agencies that there is no fully functional hospital, on proposed site and on required land allotted to the proposed college then the whole responsibility will be of the State Govt./concerned university and CCIM will not held any responsibility in the matter.
