

THE TAMILNADU Dr.M.G.R. MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, CHENNAI
REGULATIONS FOR THE POST GRADUATE DEGREE (MASTERS IN
HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT ON DISTANCE EDUCATION MODE)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 44 of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai Act 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987) the Standing Academic Board of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai hereby makes the following regulations:-

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

These regulations shall be called Post Graduate Degree (Masters in Health Care Management on Distance Education mode) of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

This shall come into force from the Academic Year 2017-2018. These regulations are subject to modifications by the Standing Academic Board from time to time. This course is not approved by the Medical Council of India.

2. AIM AND OBJECTIVES:

The Post Graduate Degree (Masters in Health Care Management on Distance Education mode) are designed as a comprehensive package wherein the candidates get exposure to various abstract disciplines with particular emphasis on their clinical skills. This course caters to the various sectors of medicine which does not have a graduate degree from recognized bodies. This program therefore can cater to finer aspects of each branch.

3. REGISTRATION:

A Candidates admitted to Post Graduate Degree (Masters in Health Care Management on Distance Education mode) of this university shall register his / her name with this university by submitting the prescribed application form for registration duly filled in, along with the prescribed fee and a declaration in the format to the Registrar of this University.

4. ELIGIBILITY :

Any UG Degree with 50% Pass Percentage obtained in any university

recognized by Council.

5. AGE LIMIT :

No upper age limit for Admission.

6. ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE :

Candidates who have passed UG Degree qualifying examination as stated in Regulation No.4 above other than the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University should obtain an “Eligibility Certificate” from this University by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application form and required documents before seeking admission to ONLINE / DISTANCE EDUCATION ON PUBLIC HEALTH. The application form is available in the University website: web.tnmgrmu.ac.in.

7. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of Post Graduate Degree (Masters in Health Care Management on Distance Education mode) is Two Years Programme.

8. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The commencement of the Courses shall be as per the University norms.

9. SELECTION OF CANDIDATES:

Selection shall be made by the University through personal Interview.

10.MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION :

English shall be the Medium of Instruction for all the Subjects of study and for examinations.

11.CURRICULUM :

The Curriculum and the Syllabus for the Course shall be as prescribed in these regulations are subject to modifications by the Standing Academic Board from time to time.

12.CUT-OFF DATE OF THE COURSE:

i) 30th September of the year concerned.

ii) The candidates admitted upto 30th September of the Academic Year shall be registered to take up the examination during 15th October of the next year.

13.COMMENCEMENT OF THE EXAMINATION:

15th October

If the date of commencement of Examination falls on Saturdays, Sundays or declared Public Holidays, the examination shall begin on the next working day.

14. WORKING DAYS IN AN ACADEMIC YEAR:

The academic year shall consist of not less than 16 hours/Semester for each subject preferably every Saturday and Sunday.

15. ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATIONS:

No candidate shall be permitted to appear for the Examination unless he/she put in **90% attendance** during his/her period of study and training.

16. CONDONATION OF BREAK OF STUDY:

The Break of Study for a period of less than 90 days can be condoned by the Head of the Department and the Break of Study for a period of more than 90 days and less than one year has to be condoned by the University authorities. The application form is available in the University website web.tnmgrmu.ac.in

17. RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY:

1. The course shall be completed with the period of Double the Duration from the date of admission.
2. The regulations for Re-admission are as per the University's Common Regulation for Re-admission.

18. MIGRATION / TRANSFER OF CANDIDATES:

Migration / Transfer of candidates from one recognized college to another recognized college of this University or from another University shall not be granted.

19. REVALUATION / RETOTALLING OF ANSWER PAPERS:

Revaluation / Retotalling of answer paper is not permitted.

20. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

Total Marks for each paper per semester is 100 (50% pass percentage) and Internal Assessment for each paper is 50 (50% pass percentage) The candidate have to get minimum of 50% mark for a pass in each component and aggregate.

Internal Assessment based on Attendance, Seminar/Presentation and continuous performance in the contact class.

University Examination Pattern Seminar/Presentation and continuous performance in the contact classes.

University Examination Pattern (Semester pattern – Every Six months):-

Part-B - Short answers

(Descriptive type) = $5 \times 6 = 30$ marks

(Descriptive type) = $5 \times 10 = 50$ marks
