Regulation of the university for Break in Internship Training.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 44 of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai – Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987), the Standing Academic Board of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University, Chennai hereby makes the following regulations.

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

These regulations shall be called “THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF INTERNSHIP TRAINING IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY, AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES OFFERED BY THE TAMIL NADU Dr. M.G.R. MEDICAL UNIVERSITY CHENNAI.

They shall come into force from 1st March 2011 onwards.

The regulations is subject to modification by the Standing Academic Board from time to time.

2. DEFINITIONS.

Break of Internship means any absence of more than Ninety days during the prescribed period of one year Internship training and more than forty five days during the prescribed period of six months Internship training.

3.UNDER GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES IN MEDICINE /DENTAL / INDIAN MEDICINE & HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES.

I) After the commencement of Internship training if the candidate has entered on break in Internship training for less than ninety days for the prescribed period of one year Internship training and for less than forty five days for the prescribed period of six months internship training, the Dean/Principal of the concerned college may condone the break in internship training and permit the candidates to continue their Internship training programme.

D) ONE YEAR INTERNSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME:

The candidate has to get condonation orders from this University for condoning the break in Internship training on the following reasons

- a) If the candidate has not commenced their internship training programme within two months from the date of publication of their final year examination result of this University.
- b) If after the commencement of Internship training, if the candidate has entered on break in Internship training for more than ninety days.

c) If the candidate has completed less than 50% of internship postings and entered on break for more than ninety days, the candidate has to re-do the entire internship training programme.

d) If the candidate has completed more than 50% of internship postings and entered on break for more than ninety days, the candidate has to undergo the balance period of internship training programme.

e) If the candidate has not completed the internship training within three years from the date of commencement of their internship training, the candidate has to undergo Refresher course for a period of three months from the institution in which the candidate has last studied. After the completion of refresher course the candidate has to re-commence the entire period of Internship training programme and complete without any break.

II) SIX MONTHS INTERNSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME:

The candidate has to get condonation orders from this University for condoning the break in Internship training on the following reasons

a) If the candidate has not commenced their internship training programme within one month from the date of publication of their final year examination result of this University.

b) If after the commencement of Internship training, if the candidate has entered on break in Internship training for more than forty five days.

c) If the candidate has completed less than 50% of internship postings and entered on break for more than forty five days, the candidate has to re-do the entire internship training programme.

d) If the candidate has completed more than 50% of internship postings and entered on break for more than forty five days, the candidate has to undergo the balance period of internship training programme.

e) If the candidate has not completed the internship training within a period of three years, from the date of commencement of their internship training the candidate has to undergo Refresher course for a period of three months from the institution in which the candidate has last studied. After the completion of refresher course the candidate has to re-commence the entire period of Internship training programme and complete without any break.

**III) APPLICABLE FOR BOTH ONE YEAR AND SIX MONTHS
INTERNSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME:**

a) If after completion of 50% of internship posting and entered on break for more than a period of one year the candidate has to re-do the entire period of internship training programme without any break.

b) No Piece meal internship training programme is allowed. If the candidate has undergone piecemeal training Programme in more than two departments during their internship period, the candidate has to re-do the entire period of Internship training and complete the internship training without any break.

c) If the break in Internship training Programme is between three years to five years, the candidate has to undergo six months refresher course from the institution in which the candidate has last studied. After the completion of Refresher course, the candidate has to re-commence the entire period of Internship training programme and complete the internship without any break.

d) If the break in Internship training programme is between six years to nine years the candidate has to undergo one year refresher course from the institution in which the candidate has last studied. After the completion of Refresher course the candidate has to recommence the entire period of internship training programme and complete the internship without any break.

e) If the break in Internship training programme is more than nine years, the candidate has to undergo the final year period of study from the institution in which the candidate has last studied. After passing the final year examination of this university, the candidate has to recommence the internship training programme and complete the internship without any break.

DEFINITION FOR REFRESHER COURSE

Refresher course means, the course to be undergone by the candidate covering all the subjects in the final year of their respective course at a pro-rato basis. For example, if the candidate belongs to M.B.B.S course and the number of subjects in the final year of M.B.B.S is six for one year, the candidate depend upon the refresher course to be ordered by this University should cover all the subjects within the prescribed period of refresher course to be undergone by them.

FEES:

The candidate has to remit a sum of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) towards processing fee for Re-admission to the internship for condoning the period of training in internship training Programme. Apart from this processing fee the candidate has to pay the following fee also for issue of orders for condoning the period of break in internship training :-

1a). For the candidates of Medical and Dental course, if the break of internship is one year, a fee of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) is payable to the University for condoning the break or part there of.

b). If the break in internship exceeds more than one year, apart from the fee of Rs. 10,000/- for the first year, an additional fee of Rs.3000/- (Rupees Three thousand only) is payable for every subsequent years.

IIb). For the candidates of Indian Medicine and Homeopathy and Allied Health Science courses, if the break of internship is one year, a fee of Rs. 7,000/- (Rupees Seven thousand only) is payable to the University for condoning the break.

c). If the break in internship exceeds more than one year apart from the fee of Rs. 7,000/- for the first year, an additional fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) is payable for every subsequent years or part there of.

GUIDELINES FOR DEANS / PRINCIPALS OF THE INSTITUTIONS:

The Deans/Principals of the colleges concerned shall not permit any candidate with a break of Internship training as stipulated above to rejoin the Internship training without obtaining the prior permission from this University.

If any candidate is permitted by the Dean / Principal of the college concerned without the prior permission of this university, the period of such Internship training shall not be considered as a recognized Internship training and such candidate shall re-do the entire period of internship training after getting necessary permission from this university irrespective of the period of break in internship.
