I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Course was held on 21.12.2015 and discussed various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Course was approved in the 51st meeting of the Standing Academic Board, held on 21.01.2016 and recorded in Resolution No:32 in the 243rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 03.03.2016 which are detailed below:

1) TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY DR.M.KRITHIGA, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, AYURVEDA COLLEGE, COIMBATORE FOR B.A.M.S. DEGREE COURSE REGARDING REVALUATION.

Resolved to accept the Resolution No.40 passed at the 234th Governing council meeting held on 3/3/2015 which is as follows:

Governing Council Resolution:

“The failed answer scripts irrespective of the marks obtained by the candidates, the double valuation is done for the marks awarded below the minimum required for a pass in the respective theory papers.”

Moreover, the passing criteria for the double valued answer scripts is as detailed below:

The average marks of the two valuation is taken or the 1st valuation marks whichever is higher.

2) THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GUIDELINES GIVEN IN THE JUDGEMENT BY HONOURABLE HIGH COURT IN W.P. NO.35108 OF 2014 – K. REGARDING APPOINTMENT OF SCRIBE IN THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION.

Resolved to implement the following guidelines of Honorable High Court Order No.W.P.(c) No.35108 of 2014 (K) dated 25.2.2015 along with the other guidelines prescribed in the office memorandum F.No.16-110/2003-DD.III dated 26th February 2013 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs:

The facility of Scribe/ Reader/Lab Assistant should be allowed to any candidate who has a disability of 40% or more if so desired by the candidate.

The word “extra time or additional time” that is being currently used should be changed to “compensatory time” and the same should not be less than 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are making use of scribe/reader/lab assistant. All the candidates with disability not availing the facility of scribe may be allowed additional time of minimum of one hour for examination of 3 hours duration which could further be increased on case to case basis”.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
