The decisions of the Board of Studies in Naturopathy & Yogic Sciences Course was approved in the 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Standing Academic Board, held on 29.09.2016 and recorded in Resolution No:32 in the 248<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Governing Council held on 08.11.2016 which are detailed below:

**THE INCLUSION OF NSS AS AN ELECTIVE SUBJECT IN THE CURRICULUM OF MEDICAL, DENTAL, NURSING, PHARMACY, INDIAN MEDICINE, HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES.**

Resolved to approve the recommendations to include the following topics of NSS as non examination elective subject in the third BNYS .

**Unit :1** Entrepreneurship Development

- a) Definition & Meaning
- b) Qualities of good entrepreneur
- c) Steps/ ways in opening an enterprise
- d) Role of financial and support service institutions

**Unit :2 Youth and Crime**

- a) Sociological and Psychological Factors influencing youth crime
- b) Peer Mentoring in preventing crimes
- c) Cyber Crime and its prevention
- e) Juvenile Justice

**Unit :3 Resource Mobilisation**

- a) Writing a Project Proposal
- b) Establishment of SFUs.

**Minimum Eligibility Criteria:**

Resolved to follow the minimum eligibility marks for admission to BNYS degree course as per the G.O. (D). No. 755 dated 14.6.2016 as there is no Central Council for BNYS.

The minimum eligibility marks is **12<sup>th</sup> Standard with science or any other equivalent examination recognized by University or Boards with fifty percent aggregate marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together.**

This will be implemented from the Academic Year 2017 -18 admission onwards.
