Allied Health Sciences Course held on 15.06.2017 and approved in the 53 rd Meeting of the Standing Academic Board Meeting held on 27.04.2017 and recorded in G C Resolution No. 25 at its 253 rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 29.06.2017.

I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in P.G. Allied Health Sciences Course was held on 15.06.2017, and discussed various academic matters and passed certain Resolutions which was placed before the 53rd Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 27.04.2017 and recorded in Resolution No. 25 passed of the 253rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 29.06.2017 which are detailed below:

POINT No.1

**FRAMING SYLLABUS, REGULATION AND GUIDELINE FOR M.Sc(BIOETHICS)
DEGREE COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.**

It was resolved to approve with some modifications in the Eligibility criteria & Teaching faculties:-

1. Name of the Course : Postgraduate Degree course – M.Sc. (Bio-Ethics)
under Allied Health Science

2. Duration : Two years programme

3. Eligibility criteria : Any UG Medical degree (MBBS, BDS, AYUSH),

B.Sc(N) & P.B.Sc(N)

The Board has recommended to remove the BPT/BOT courses from the Eligibility Criteria.

The approved Syllabus and Regulations are uploaded in the University Website.

POINT No.2

FRAMING OF THE REGULATIONS, SYLLABUS AND GUIDELINES TO START M.Sc RADIOTHERAPY TECHNOLOGY DEGREE COURSE AND TO INCLUDE AERB RECOMMENDATIONS IN B.Sc (RADIOTHERAPY TECHNOLOGY) COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.

It was resolved to include the Radiation safety syllabus in B.Sc. Radiotherapy Technology , M.Sc. Radiotherapy Technology, B.Sc. (Radiology and Imaging Technology) and M.Sc. (Radiology and Imaging Technology) as recommended by AERB. (approved Syllabus and Regulations uploaded in the University Website).

This will be implemented from the academic year 2017-2018 admissions onwards.

POINT No.3

REVISION OF SYLLABUS, REGULATION AND GUIDELINES FOR M.PHIL. (CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY) DEGREE COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES AS PER COUNCIL NORMS.

It was resolved to approve the revised Syllabus, Guidelines and Regulations for the existing M.Phil (Clinical Psychology) course as per Rehabilitation Council of India recommendations and this will be implemented from the academic year 2017-2018 admission onwards. (Revised Syllabus uploaded in the University Website)

POINT NO.4

FRAMING OF SYLLABUS AND REGULATIONS FOR STARTING THE POST GRADUATE DEGREE MASTERS IN HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT (MHM) THROUGH DISTANCE EDUCATION MODE.

It was resolved to approve the Syllabus and Regulations for starting the Post Graduate Degree Masters in Health Care Management (MHM) Through Distance Education Mode:

- 1. Name of the Course** : Postgraduate Degree – Masters in Health care Management (MHM) on Distance Education Mode.
- 2. Duration** : Two years programme
- 3. Eligibility criteria** : Any UG with 50% pass percentage
- 4. Selection of the Candidate** : By the University through Personal Interview.

5. Commencement of the Course : As per University norms with separate Department with Course Director and staff (3-4) Nos.)

6. Working days : Not less than 16 hours / semester / for each subject preferably Every Saturday & Sunday.

7. Attendance : 90% attendance is mandatory.

8. Scheme of Examination:-

Total Marks for each paper per semester is 100 (50% pass percentage) and Internal Assessment for each paper is 50(50% pass percentage). The candidate have to secure minimum of 50% mark for a pass in each component & Aggregate.

Internal Assessment based on Attendance, Seminar / Presentation and continuous performance in the contact classes.

University Examination Pattern (Semester pattern – Every six months):-

Part – B - Short answers = 5 x 6 = 30 marks
(Descriptive type)

Part – C - Essays = 5 x 10 = 50 marks

POINT No. 6

TO PERMIT THE CANDIDATES OF P.G. DIPLOMA IN HEALTH PROMOTION & EDUCATION COURSE ADMITTED AFTER THE CUT OFF DATE TO WRITE THE EXAM IN MAY 2017

It was resolved that as a one time measure, to permit the candidates of PG Diploma in Health Promotion and Education (2016-2017) admitted upto 31st July 2016 to appear for University examination in May 2017 session after fulfilling IA/Attendance requirements of University.

The candidates admitted in August 2016 shall be permitted to appear for the University Examinations in October 2017 session only.

Further, it is also resolved that the Institution should be strictly instructed to follow the University common cut off dates for admission in future (i.e.,) 30th September.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Heads of Departments, Professors and Students for information and for further follow up action in this regard. I also request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
