I am to inform you that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Physiotherapy and
Occupational Therapy Courses which was held on 11.04.2017 and discussed various academic
matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy
Courses were approved by the 53rd Meeting of the Standing Academic Board, which was held
on 27.04.2017 and passed in the 253rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 29.06.2017
which are detailed below:

POINT NO:1

**TO INCLUDE YOGA AS ONE OF THE SUBJECTS IN BPT & MPT CURRICULUM BASED
ON THE UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION, NEW DELHI.**

It was resolved to include Yoga as one of the Subjects in BPT, BOT, MPT & MOT
curriculum based on the recommendations of University Grants Commission, New Delhi.

POINT NO:2

EXPERT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDED TO FOLLOW THE REVISED SYLLABUS FOR BPT DEGREE COURSE

It was resolved to implement to follow the revised syllabus for BPT degree course. This will be implemented from the academic year 2017-2018 admission onwards.(revised syllabus available in the website)

POINT NO:3

CERTAIN POINTS BPT/MPT SYLLABUS REVISION

It was **resolved** to approve the following for B.P.T. Degree course :

- 1.Question paper setting for Anatomy and Physiology subjects in Physiotherapy will be done by the faculty who are teaching physiotherapy students only.
2. Rearrangements of all the clinical subjects in III year and Physiotherapy subjects in the final year have been done in the revised syllabus.

For Master of Physiotherapy course:-

Inclusion of Teaching Methodology and revision of MPT syllabus will be done subsequently by convening an Expert Committee.

MOT

It was **resolved** to increase the MOT guideship strength from 3 to 4 students for Professor(s) and 2 to 3 students for Associate Professor(s).

POINT NO.4

AWARD OF MODERATION MARKS

It was resolved to Award a total of 10 marks, subject to a maximum of five marks per paper, as moderation to be distributed among all the failed papers in Theory, Practical and Oral in Physiotherapy and Occupational therapy courses.

Academic Board, which was held on 27.04.2017 and passed in the 253rd Meeting of the
Governing Council held on 29.06.2017 which are detailed below:-

THE INCLUSION OF ONE MORE CLAUSE IN THE EXISTING REGULATIONS FOR
CONDONATION OF BREAK OF STUDY IN FIRST YEAR OF POST GRADUATE DEGREE
COURSES (MPT/MOT) OF THIS UNIVERSITY.

1. It was resolved to follow the existing regulations for condonation of Break of
study under serial No. 5 (b).

If any candidate completed the course of study, appeared for final year examinations but

failed in one or more subjects and does not consecutively appear for two supplemental examinations, shall undergo a refresher course for a period of six months after obtaining the permission from the University for undergoing such refresher course in the college in which he/she last studied and obtained a certificate to that effect before appearing for the failed subjects of final year examination in the course. The examination application shall be forwarded through the Dean/Principal of the college concerned.

2. It was also resolved the the first year subjects can be carried over to the second year and the regular attendance is mandatory to appear for the final year examination.
