Ref:	Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Studies in U.G. Allied Health Science Courses held on 03.12.2019 and approved in the 58 <sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 17.12.2019 and passed on G.C. Resolution No.21 at its 274 <sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Governing Council held on 22.01.2020.

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I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Allied Health Science U.G. Degree/Diploma Courses was held on 03.12.2019 and discussed various academic matters and passed certain Resolutions which was placed before the 58<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 17.12.2019 and recorded in Resolution No.21, passed at the 274<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Governing Council held on 22.01.2020 which are detailed as below:-

**POINT NO:1**

**TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE FACULTIES FOR QUESTION PAPER SETTING, PAPER EVALUATION AND EXAMINERS FOR PRACTICAL EXAMINATION BASED ON THE SYLLABUS FOR BSC.,- FITNESS AND LIFESTYLE MODIFICATION DEGREE COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.**

The Board Members in principle approved the Syllabus and Regulations of B.Sc.,-Fitness and Life Style Modifications course under Allied Health Sciences and suggested to conduct an Expert Committee to discuss with regard to the eligibility of appointing a Faculty for Kalari, Yoga, Martial Arts and Dance since these subjects/topics are converted as Internal Papers for First Year, Second Year and Third Year respectively. This will be implemented from August 2020 Examination.

The SAB has approved the above agenda and this will be implemented from August 2020 Examination onwards.

The change of Nomenclature of Paper III of First Year – Nutrition and Life Style Modification and Paper I of Second Year – Psychology and Life Style Modification of the course “B.Sc.,- Fitness and Life Style Modification” is accepted,

Henceforth, it shall be named as Nutrition (PAPER III OF FIRST YEAR) and Psychology (PAPER I OF SECOND YEAR) respectively by deleting term “Life Style Modification”. This will be implemented from the Academic Year 2020-2021 Admission onwards.

The SAB has approved the above agenda and this will be implemented from August 2020 – 2020 Admission onwards.

**POINT NO :2**

**TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE TO START BSC DEGREE IN CLINICAL TRIAL AND CLINICAL DATA MANAGEMENT COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES.**

The Standing Academic Board resolved to approve the Syllabus, Regulation & Guidelines framed for starting of the course B.Sc., Degree in Clinical Trial and Clinical Data Management under UG Allied Health Sciences.

ii) It was resolved to include Internal Assessment & Attendance Guidelines in the Regulation.

iii) It was also resolved to include the above course in the Group II pertaining to the Basic Science Syllabus.

**ANY OTHER ITEM**

(a) To include Blood Grouping, Hemoglobin, HIV, Hepatitis B & C and not to include Urine Testing & Tissues in Microscope in Microbiology Syllabus.

(b) Not to include Injections topic in Anatomy and Physiology Paper.

(c) B.Sc.,-Physician Assistant in Group II to be included in the Group pertaining to Common Basic Sciences Syllabus.

The Standing Academic Board approved the above points.

To prescribe a Common Log Book for all UG AHS Courses.

**The Standing Academic Board has not approved for Common Log Book instead a Specific Log Book for individual Allied Health Science Courses and suggested to have a Standard Practical Examination Pattern for each course.**

Members suggested to appoint a Post Graduate qualified with Five Years of Teaching Experience / Ph.D. qualified individuals as Post Graduate Examiner for MASLP course and Post Graduate in MASLP qualified can be appointed as Examiner for BASLP Course.

**The Standing Academic Board resolved that a Faculty of MASLP with Five Years of Teaching Experience / Ph.D. qualified individuals shall be a Post Graduate Examiner for MASLP course and a Faculty of MASLP with two years teaching experience can be appointed as Examiner for BASLP Course.**

**The Standing Academic Board approved to include the following topics in the Final Year Syllabus of B.Sc.,-Operation Theatre and Anaesthesia Technology.**

1. Anaesthesia for Transplant Procedures
2. Anaesthesia for Burns and
3. Anaesthesia for Ophthalmic Procedures

The Standing Academic Board resolved that the affiliated institutions should obtain AERB approval for conducting B.Sc.,-Radiography and Imaging Technology, B.Sc.,-Radiotherapy Technology and B.Sc.,-Nuclear Medicine courses.

I am to request that the above decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above is communicated to all the Head of Departments, Professors and students for information and further follow up action in this regard. I also request that a copy of this letter shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for information of the students concern.
