TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GUIDELINES GIVEN BY THE INC IN VARIOUS DATES DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC/LOCKDOWN.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to implement the following as per the advisory issued by INC vide circular F.No. 1-6/2020-INC, dated: 14.05.2020, on Academic and Examination during COVID-19 pandemic of lockdown for implementation.

- Resolved to Use Online modes of teaching to continue the educational process by making effective use of technology.
- Resolved to cover the theory portion of the syllabus in various subjects Through Online classes.
- Resolved to treat the period of lock down as “deemed to be attended” by all the students while calculating the requirement of minimum percentage of attendance.
- Resolved to grant two months extension to ensure completion of Clinical Requirements in Academic Session 2019-2020 for conducting examination.
- Resolved to count Summer vacation during lockdown period.
- Resolved to commence Academic Session 2020-2021 from September 2020.
- Resolved to conduct Examinations as and when Normalcy is restored and to give priority to final year examinations.
- Resolved to relax attendance requirement in each practical area to 80%.
- Resolved to conduct theory examination after opening of Lockdown in staggered timetable form, without compromising the quality, so that the examination process may be completed in multiple shifts.
- Resolved to permit students to attend next higher classes and shall appear for the previous year examinations as and when conducted by the University.

ANY OTHER ITEM

The Standing Academic Board has resolved to implement the marking system for internship from the Academic year 2020-2021 instead of 2019-2020 in lieu of COVID-19 Pandemic situation.
