TO CONSIDER AND DECIDE ON THE METHODOLOGY OF CONDUCTING POST DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP IN CLINICAL EXAMINATION FOR THOSE CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR JULY 2020 EXAM SESSION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC SITUATION.

The Standing Academic Board resolved to conduct clinical examination in Post Doctoral Fellowship course in Medical and Surgical specialties only after giving adequate training and those who have eligible attendance to appear for examination. Further it was resolved to conduct examinations at a conducive point of time preferably mid of October/November 2020.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that candidates, who have not undergone adequate training in the prescribed period, should complete the training before appearing for examinations. This is given as one-time measure in lieu of COVID-19 pandemic.
