The following resolutions passed by the Standing Academic Board were approved by the Governing Council at the 277th meeting held on 30.09.2020.

AGENDA NO.1

TO DISCUSS AND DECIDE TO EXEMPT THE INTERNSHIP PERIOD BEYOND MARCH 2020 FOR THE STUDENTS OF 2016-2017 BATCH UNDERGOING BASLP COURSE UNDER ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE AS A ONE-TIME MEASURE AS PER THE CIRCULAR OF REHABILITATION COUNCIL OF INDIA DUE TO COVID-19.

It was resolved to exempt the internship period from March 2020 for the students of 2016-2017 batch undergoing BASLP course in lieu of COVID-19 pandemic BASED ON THE CIRCULAR FROM REHABILITATION COUNCIL OF INDIA. This is given as one-time measure considering the current pandemic.

It was resolved to conduct practical examinations for arrear candidates at a conducive point of time. Further resolved that the head of the institution shall permit first and second year candidates to attend next higher classes, however the candidates have to appear for the practical examinations as and when conducted by the University and clear the subjects, before taking up examinations of next higher class. This is given as one-time measure in lieu of COVID-19 pandemic.
