I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in UG Allied Health Science Degree courses held on 07.11.2024 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 63rd meeting held on 21.11.2024. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 303rd meeting held on 28.11.2024. The Standing Academic Board has resolved as follows:

- To continue the existing nomenclature of B.Sc. Critical Care Technology.
- To approve Open Book Examination for the Final Year B.Sc Medical Record Science Paper – I.
- To conduct Examination for Third Year B.Sc Allied Health Science for the candidates admitted in the Academic Year 2021- 2022 in the month of January 2025 instead of April 2025. Further, the Board recommended to send communication about conducting of examination in January to the Institutions through mail/Website immediately
- Soft Skill Development Programme can be conducted as Value Added course only.
- To continue the existing Syllabus and Regulation of 2018-2019 for UG Allied Health Science Degree courses.
- Further resolved to follow the Internship Regulations as follows:
- **Eligibility and Start of Internship:** The candidates are eligible to start their internship after they have cleared all the papers successfully and the results are published. The students should start their internship not later than 1 month from the date of publication of the results in the University website.
- **Duration:** The duration of internship is 1 year for all the degree courses under Allied Health Sciences including Lateral Entry admissions except the following courses,

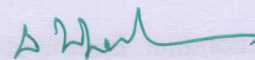

- **Working Hours:** The working hours per day during Internship would be 8 hours (Maximum 6 days a week).
- **Attendance and Leaves during Internship:** Interns shall be permitted a maximum of 15 days (Normal Leave) with prior permission for a one-year period (7.5 days for a 6 months internship). A maximum of 5 days is allowed in a posting which has a duration of 1 month or more and not more than 2 days for minor postings which has lesser duration. Any other leaves including medical leave shall be included within the 15 days of Normal Leave.
- **Time Limit:** The time limit to complete Internship would be within the stipulated time period as mentioned above. The minimum period of the compulsory rotatory internship may be extended appropriately equivalent to the period beyond the permissible quota of leave. The internship shall be repeated in the department / posting / specialty wherein the above extension is necessary.
- **Break of Internship:** Any condonation in the break of Internship is as per the existing rules and with prior permission from the University.
- To provide copy of the evaluated answer sheets along with marks as per mark statement to the students on request. Accordingly, the photo copy of the answer scripts will be provided with distribution of marks for each answer, to the failed candidates.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of Departments of your Institution for Information and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for the information of the Students.
