I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Degree courses held on 23.10.2024 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 63rd meeting held on 21.11.2024. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 303rd meeting held on 28.11.2024. The Standing Academic Board has resolved as follows:

- To follow the Academic Calendar for Ayurveda UG Program (BAMS) for all Batch as per NCISM norms.
- To conduct Final Year Examination in June 2025 for 2020-2021 batch BAMS students.
- The updated list of eligible Examiners to be obtained from the affiliated institutions prior to two month of conducting examinations and for Valuation.
- To send Practical / Clinical / Viva-Voce Examination schedule along with the Theory Examination Schedule.

- To follow new Course Curriculum for First and Second Professional B.A.M.S UG Degree Course introduced by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine.
- A candidate obtaining sixty-five per cent and above marks shall be awarded first class in the subject and seventy five per cent and above marks shall be awarded distinction in the subject. The award of class and distinction shall not be applicable for supplementary examinations as per the norms of NCISM.
- The student shall be required to maintain minimum seventy five per cent attendance in each subject in theory (i.e lecture hours) practical and clinical (i.e non-lecture hours) separately for appearing in examination as per norms of NCISM.
- To provide OMR sheet for MCQ at the beginning of the Examination and the Invigilator should collect and seal the bundle of answered OMR immediately.

To provide copy of the evaluated answer sheets along with marks to the students on request.

The University can accept Endowment for medal, only if students of all the affiliated institutions are allowed to participate in the medal examination.

To start course on B.Pharm (Ayurveda) & B.Sc Nursing (Ayurveda).
