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I am to inform you that, the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Homoeopathy Degree courses held on 22.10.2024 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 63rd meeting held on 21.11.2024. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 303rd meeting held on 28.11.2024. The Standing Academic Board has resolved as follows:

To implement the National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospital) Regulations 2024 by the Affiliation wing of this University.

To establish “**Center of Excellence in Homoeopathic Research**” at affiliated Homoeopathy institutions of this University.

To conduct Online Workshop on Research Methodology for Third Year BHMS students by the Department of Epidemiology of this University.

To adhere the New CBDC Syllabus implemented as on date by National Commission for Homoeopathy.

A student shall be required to maintain at least seventy-five percent attendance in each subject in theory (i.e., lecture hours) practical and clinical (i.e., non-lecture hours) separately for appearing in examination as per the norms of National Commission for Homoeopathy.

A candidate obtaining sixty-five percent. and above marks shall be awarded first class in the subject and seventy-five percent. and above marks shall be awarded distinction in the subject as per the norms of National Commission for Homoeopathy.

To constitute an Expert Committee to form guidelines with regard to establishment of Medical Education Technology Unit, IQAC & Pharmacovigilance in Homoeopathy Medical Colleges which are mandatory as per the latest Minimum Education Standards (MES) by NCH.

To updated list of eligible Examiners (foreach year particularly Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine and Case Taking & Repertory) to be obtained from the affiliated institutions prior to one month of conducting examinations and for Valuation.

To include the "**Dissertation**" Column in the Header of TMR in the MD Homoeopathy Degree Course of Part – II Examination. Further to add the result of Dissertation in the Mark Statement.

To implement the guidelines for the Double Valuation System in Under Graduate Examinations of BHMS Degree Course as prescribed in the Regulations of 2022-2023 as per the Notification of the National Commission for Homoeopathy.

- All the answer scripts shall be subjected for two valuations by the concerned University. The highest of the total marks awarded by the two evaluators for the paper, which is rounded off to the nearest value, shall be considered for computation of the results.
- Failed candidates answer scripts after double valuation are subjected to third valuation.
- The highest of the three total marks, awarded by the three valutors for the paper, rounded off to the nearest value, shall be considered for final computation of the results.
- After the computation and declaration of the results, re-valuation is not permitted by any authority under any circumstances.

To approve the modifications in the new template & subject codes in the Statement of Marks for the First Professional BHMS Degree Course Examinations as prescribed in the Regulations of 2022-2023, as per the Notifications of the National Commission for Homoeopathy.

To provide OMR sheet for MCQ at the beginning of the Examination and the Invigilator should collect and seal the bundle of answered OMR immediately.


To provide copy of the evaluated answer sheets along with marks to the students on request. Accordingly the photocopy of the answer scripts will be provided with distribution of marks for each answer, to the failed candidates.

The university will accept Endowment for medal, only if students of all the affiliated institutions are allowed to participate in the medal examination.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above be communicated to all the Professors and Head of Departments of your Institution for information and a copy of this letter be displayed on the Notice Board of the College/Hostel for the information of the Students.
