The Government of Tamil Nadu have instituted two Endowments
viz.,

1. RAJIV GANDHI ENDOWMENT
2. ANNAI SATHYA ENDOWMENT

to award Scholarship to the best students in the Government Colleges/Institution affiliated to this University. .

The following guidelines should be followed for award of Rajiv Gandhi and Annai Sathya Endowments.

- a) To award the scholarship to the students, the parental income of the student is not essential for the selection of candidates.
- b) The students who receive any other scholarship, stipend or fellowship are also eligible for the award of these Scholarship.
- c) No communal consideration need be added while awarding the scholarship as this scholarship is based on MERIT only.
- d) The basic criterion for making the students eligible for receiving the Scholarship shall be the marks obtained by a student in the qualifying Examination (i.e. +2) for admission to a particular course. The recipient of the scholarship shall have to prove his/her ability in the subsequent examination to continue to draw the scholarship.

- e) The scholarship of Rajiv Gandhi and Annai Sathya Endowment is awarded to the U.G students of the Govt. Colleges only.
- f) Rs. 5000/- shall be awarded to each candidate per year till the completion of duration of the course of study.
- g) One candidate from each speciality will be awarded as given below:
Each candidate from one speciality i.e from Medical, Dental, Nursing, BPT/BOT, Siddha, Ayurveda, Unani, Homeopathy Naturopathy and Pharmacy.
- h) The selection of candidates shall be done in the first year of study based on the marks obtained by them in the Higher Secondary Exam.and to continue the scholarship in subsequent years, the candidates should obtain a minimum of 70 % of marks in each subject throughout the course of their study.
- i) The candidates, selected through Selection Committee alone are eligible to receive the above scholarship. The Selection for award of Scholarship is purely on Merit basis.

3. The Deans/ Principals are requested to send the Nominations of the Ist year U.G Students of all courses admitted in the A.Y.2014-2015 who fulfill all the above mentioned conditions on or before **31.10.2014** along with the following documents.

- i) Xerox copy of + 2 Marks Statements (duly attested by the Dean/ Principals concerned)
- ii) Xerox copies of Ration Card.

4.The Deans / Principals are hereby informed that Nominations received without the required documents as mentioned above and unaccompanied by requisite information will summarily be rejected.

5.The Deans/ Principals are also requested to display this communication prominently in the College Notice Board also under title.
