The FC GC approval were read and the action taken and implementation was discussed

The advantages of the online screening was evident . The turnaround time between evaluation and publishing of the results came down to 2 hours in MCh course which was a revelation. Laurels were given to the VC Mam for her idea.

An IMDS lab was established. The antimicrobial resistance lab was inaugurated. As the number of candidates appearing of PhDs were increasing the lecture hall of the first floor was refurbished with all acoustic facilities and wifi connection ,smart board for teaching and cme was inaugurated.

a novel idea of conducting an international conference on Holistic medicine integrating all branches of medicine was mooted out with no financial commitment to the university.

Auditorium utilization was discussed and it was decided to throw it open to all academic functions. It was decided to utilize the guest house for housing the officials and examiners at a cost borne by the colleges for whom the examiner is being appointed.

Many new courses were proposed according to the necessity the community was discussed. The expert needs to be called for the framing of the syllabus faculty needs for each course and infrastructure facilities books required for the course needs to be documented.

The syllabus which was not revamped for yester years were revamped with a objective in mind. Experts in every course should be called and changes made within the frame work of the regulatory bodies.
