The possibility of online evaluation of the PG scripts was thoroughly discussed. This would avoid shuffling- this would maintain the confidentiality and the answer paper would be secured. All technical error would be avoided.

Automatic allocation of the answer booklets would be allotted to the evaluators and bias between staff and evaluators could be avoided. Also no tags in answers sheet can be traced

The scripts are usually evaluated by four different evaluators and this would ensure that the evaluator will not know which evaluation he is being allotted. This may increase pass percentage multiple valuations may go on at the same time. This would reduce the time and man power to allot answer booklets and restore them after evaluation. Marks allotment will be within range and none of the answers can be overseen. Totaling is done by the system s technical mistakes can be avoided. The results can be published at a very early time –

So though the cost involved in scanning by an outsource dept and hiring computers for minimum of three months may be costly it would be worth the try.
