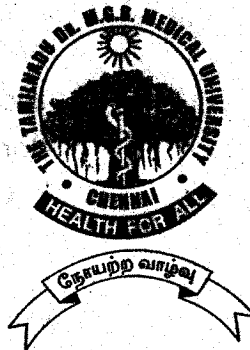

Laws of the University

The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University

(Affiliation of Medical Technology Courses – (VIZ) Bachelor of Medical Technology in Radio Diagnosis (BMT(RD)), Bachelor of Medical Technology in Radio Therapy (BMT(RT)) and Bachelor of Medical Technology in Nuclear Medicine (BMT(NM) Statutes)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42 of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987), the Governing Council of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, hereby makes the following statutes.

1. (1) These statutes may be called the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University (Affiliation of Bachelor of Medical Technology (viz) BACHELOR OF MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY IN RADIO DIAGNOSIS (BMT(RD)), BACHELOR OF MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY IN RADIO THERAPY (BMT(RT)) AND BACHELOR OF MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY IN NUCLEAR MEDICINE (BMT(NM) COURSE) Statutes.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of assent of the Chancellor.
2. The words and phrases used in these statutes shall unless the context otherwise, requires, have the same meaning as they have with reference to the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987) hereinafter called "the Act".
3. The college/Medical institutions / Hospital seeking affiliation to the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai for starting of I year bachelor of Medical Technology in Radio diagnosis (BMT) (RD) / I year Bachelor of Medical Technology in Radiotherapy (BMT) (RT) / I year Bachelor of Medical Technology in Nuclear medicine (BMT) (NM) Degree course of study shall apply in Form I in the annexure hereto for Certificate of Registration with the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

Note : Registration shall be made for one / two / three courses at a time.

4. The duration of the above said Bachelor of Medical Technology degree courses shall be three years each.
- 5 (1) The Medical colleges which are conducting MBBS degree course of study and recognized by the Medical Council of India are eligible to apply for affiliation for any one or more number of the said Bachelor of Medical Technology degree courses of study; and
- (2) The Medical Institutions / Hospitals within the jurisdiction of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, which are conducting Medical Council of India recognized Post Graduate Diploma courses / Master degree course in Radiodiagnosis or Radiotherapy / having facilities in Nuclear medicine for diagnosis and treatment are eligible to apply for affiliation for respective any one or more number of the said Bachelor of Medical Technology degree courses of study.

6. (a) The application for the Certificate of Registration shall be in Form I, annexed to these statutes and addressed to the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai. The application shall be submitted to the University between the 1st July and 31st October of the academic year preceding to which affiliation is sought for. The prescribed application Form I shall be obtained from the University on payment of a sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time, by means of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai. The filled in application shall be submitted to the Registrar of this University along with the Demand Draft for a sum of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards processing fee.
- (b) The application for Certificate of Registration shall be submitted along with the permission of the Government of Tamil Nadu.
7. (1) The application for Certificate of Registration shall contain the following particulars, namely :-
 - (a) Name of the Medical College / Medical Institution / Hospital
 - (b) Name of the Medical College / Medical Institution / Hospital in which the course is proposed to be started.
 - (c) Name and address of the promoting body (i.e.) Trust / Society :
 - (d) Particulars where the Medical technology course is to be conducted with telephone number, Fax, e-mail etc. if available.
 - (e) The number of students proposed to be admitted in the first year of the course :
 - (f) The details regarding the availability of the ready built area facility for training and other physical infrastructure provided exclusively for the students of each BMT course proposed to be admitted.
 - (g) Ready built area available for the accommodation of the academic complex.
 - (h) Whether the college has fully complied with the guidelines of the University with regard to the conducting of BMT course.
 - (i) Playground
 - (j) Hostel;
 - (k) Record showing the prior permission of the Government of Tamil Nadu for starting the course.
 - (l) Such other particulars as may be required by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, from time to time.
- (2) The applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital shall also enclose a Demand Draft for Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time drawn in favour of the Registrar, towards the inspection fee to the University for deputing its Inspection Commission along with their application for Certificate of Registration.

8. On receipt of the application for Certificate of Registration, the University shall scrutinize the same and verify by deputing an inspection commission, as to whether the following conditions are fulfilled by the applicant to become eligible to receive the certificate of Registration.

- (a) The applicant shall own a ready built area of not less than 1000 square meter exclusively suitable for conducting each of the I year B.M.T. (RD / RT / NM) course and 2000 sq. mt. for entire course separately for each with proper sanitation facilities, provision for safe drinking water, adequate water supply for clinical and laboratory purposes, library, store rooms, toilets for students, staff (Separately for men and women) and such other facilities which shall be necessary from time to time as may be specified by the University in this regard.
- (b) It shall furnish a budget for each year of study and a separate development budget which will cover the expenses for the fulfilment of the requirements prescribed for the second and third year of the course of study.
- (c) The college shall satisfy the University that the lacunae, if any, pointed out in the earlier inspections of the college with regard of MBBS degree course of study Post Graduate Diploma course / Master degree in Radiodiagnosis or Radio Therapy have already been rectified.

9. The University, if fully satisfied on the basis of the Inspection report that all the conditions to receive the Certificate of Registration for starting the first year BMT (RD/RT/NM) Degree course are fulfilled, shall issue a Certificate of registration in Form II annexed to these statutes, to the applicant to enable it to make further arrangements to start the First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study after collecting a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the fee for issue of Certificate of Registration.

The issue of Certificate of Registration alone shall not confer any right on the applicant to start the B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study.

10. The applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital on receipt of Certificate of Registration from the University shall apply to the University for provisional affiliation of First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study in Form III annexed to these statutes, and shall fulfill the conditions stipulated in statute 11 to enable the University to appoint and send an inspection commission.

11. 1) For applying for Provisional affiliation for the first year BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study, the applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital shall produce evidence of having;

- (a) (i) qualified staff members of the specialities, who are either already members of the faculty with adequate time to handle the BMT (RD/RT/NM) course classes.

(OR)

- (ii) qualified persons who have consented to join as members of the faculty of the college / Institution / Hospital after starting the course with their consent letters or appointment orders.

- (b) have minimum of the qualified staff members essential for the First year BMT (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study shall be;

The applicant college shall also give an undertaking to the effect that they shall appoint all the members who are consented to join the college as in statute 11.1) (a) (ii) before the grant of provisional affiliation by the University.

Note :

- (1) The above staff is essential for a maximum sanctioned intake upto 10 (Ten) students only.
- (2) The staff already exist under Post Graduate courses can be utilized for this course without affecting the conduct of the Post Graduate courses concerned.
- (c) The applicant shall produce evidence to the effect that the proposed Medical Technology course (BMT (RD/RT/NM)) is fully equipped in the following aspects :-
 - (i) Facilities for teaching anatomy, physiology, Medical physics
 - (ii) Facilities for teaching Radio diagnosis / Radiotherapy/Nuclear Medicine.
 - (iii) A Physics Laboratory with a minimum space of 30 feet x 30 feet
 - (iv) A physiology laboratory with a minimum space of 30 feet x 30 feet
 - (v) A anatomy museum with a minimum space of 30 feet x 30 feet
 - (vi) A multi purpose hall for conduct of meetings, seminars, examinations etc.
 - (vii) Minimum of three common rooms one for faculty, one for students and one for office staff with minimum space of 50 feet x 30 feet each.
 - (viii) A Class Room for teaching not less than 15 x 15 sq.ft.
- (d) Library facility :— Books relevant to the speciality minimum 50 Nos.
current Journals minimum 5 Nos.
- 2) The college / Medical Institution / Hospital which satisfy the above conditions / faculties shall admit not more than 10 students for each year for BMT (RD/RT/NM) course.
- 3) The qualifications for appointment to the posts of Professor, Assistant Professor, Lecturer and Radiodiagnosis Technologists shall be as follows :-

- (1) **Professor – Radio diagnosis :**
Master degree in Radiodiagnosis (MD (RD) from a recognized University with 10 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
 - (2) **Professor – Radiotherapy :**
Master degree in Radiotherapy (MD (RT) from a recognized University with 10 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
 - (3) **Professor – Nuclear Medicine :**
Master degree in RD or RT (MD (RD or RT) with DRM from a recognized University with 10 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
 - (4) **Professor – Medical Physics :**
M.Sc (physics) plus Dip.R.P. (BARC) from a recognized University (or) M.Sc. medical physics from a recognized University with 10 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
 - (5) **Assistant Professor – Anatomy :**
Master degree in anatomy from a recognised University with 3 years teaching experience in the concerned field.
 - (6) **Assistant Professor – Physiology :**
Master degree in Physiology from recognised University with 3 years teaching experience in the concerned filed.
 - (7) **Lecturer – Medical Physics :**
M.Sc (Physics) plus Dip. R.P. (BARC) from a recognized University (or) M.Sc. (Medical physics) from a recognized University.
 - (8) **Radiodiagnosis technologist :**
Bachelor's degree in Radiological technology (or) Diploma course in Radiological Technology with 3 year hospital experience in the concerned field (or) certificate course in Radiological Technology with 5 years hospital experience in the concerned field.
12. The applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital which fulfil the conditions stipulated in statute 11, shall apply to the University in writing along with the Demand Draft for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time, towards the inspection fee payable to the University.
 13. On receipt of the above intimation, the University shall send its inspection commission to inspect the facilities available in the college for the proposed Medical Technology Course and to submit report to the University. The inspection commission shall also report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfilment of any of the conditions required to be fulfilled and also advise as to the capability of the applicant to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months. In case there are lacunae in the fulfilment of the conditions, the University may conduct re-inspection on payment of a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the re-inspection fee and shall receive a final report from the inspection commission.

14. On a detailed examination of the report of the inspection commission if the University is fully satisfied as to the fulfilment of the conditions for affiliation for the First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study, the University shall direct the applicant to remit a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) towards the security deposit. The security deposit shall be invested in a Fixed Deposit in a Nationalized Bank or Government Undertaking / Corporation jointly in the name of the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai and the management of the college. The Fixed Deposit receipt shall be kept in the custody of the Registrar. The interest accrued on the Fixed Deposit shall be spent towards the expenses connected with the conduct of the Medical technology course and the applicant shall submit an utilization certificate in this regard in Form IV annexed to these statutes, at the end of every academic year.
15. On the remittance of security deposit under statute 14 and on payment of the affiliation fee of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards provisional affiliation fee for the first year by the college, the University shall grant provisional affiliation for the First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study. The University may withdraw the provisional affiliation granted herein after giving three months notice stating the reasons therefor and after considering the explanation of the management of the applicant.
16. The applicant shall furnish evidence of annual income of not less than Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) being a portion of the annual liability of the college towards payment of salaries to the teaching staff and the maintenance of the Departments.
17. On grant of provisional affiliation the management of the college / Medical Institution / Hospital shall inform the University that all the required staff as per statute 11 have already been appointed and are in position to take classes.
18. The University shall, on fulfilment of the requirement under statute 17, issue orders to the college / Medical Institution / Hospital to admit students in such number as may be specified by the University.

The provisional affiliation granted by the University shall be only for the First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study.

19. When six months period is left for the First Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course Examinations, the applicant shall apply to the University for provisional affiliation of the second year of the course in Form III annexed to these statutes with a demand draft for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing council from time to time, drawn in favour of the Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai towards the inspection fee and request the University to depute its inspection commission.

Before applying so, the applicant shall provide the following facilities and appoint the faculties required for conduct of the second year of the course.

(b) Qualifications for appointment of teaching staff mentioned above :-

1. Asst. Professor – Medical physics : M.Sc. (physics) and Dip. R.P. (BARC) from a recognized University (or) M.Sc. Medical physics from a recognised University and 3 years teaching experience in the concerned field along with certification from AERB to work as a RSO in medical institutions.
2. Asst. Professor – Radiodiagnosis : Master degree in radiodiagnosis (MD(RD)) from a recognised University and 3 years teaching experience in the concerned field.
3. Asst. Professor – Radiotherapy : Master degree in Radiotherapy (MD(RT)) from a recognised University and 3 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
4. Asst. Professor – Nuclear medicine : Master degree or PG diploma in Nuclear medicine from a recognised University and 3 years of teaching experience in the concerned field.
5. Radio diagnosis technologist : Bachelor degree in Radiological technology (or) Diploma Course in Radiological Technology and 3 years hospital experience (or) certificate course in Radiological Technology and 5 years hospital experience in the concerned field.
6. Radiotherapy Technologist : Bachelor degree in Radiotherapy technology (or) Diploma Course in Radiotherapy Technology and 3 years hospital experience (or) certificate course in Radiotherapy Technology and 5 years hospital experience in the concerned field.
7. Nuclear Medicine Technologist : Bachelor degree in Nuclear Medicine Technology (or) Post graduate Diploma in Radioisotope Technology (DMRIT) (or) Diploma course in Radioisotope Technology and 3 years hospital experience.

(c) Clinical Facilities :

(i) For BMT (RD) degree course

A well set up Radiology department with all imaging modalities including dental, General radiography, fluoroscopy, CT scan, MRI and ultrasound equipments.

(ii) For BMT (RT) degree course

A well set up Radiotherapy department with all treatment facilities to treat cancer patients, including teletherapy (Co-60 units / Linear accelerators) Brachytherapy (manual / after loading systems / remote control after loading systems), simulators, treatment planning systems.

(iii) For BMT (NM) degree course :

A well set up Nuclear Medicine department with all diagnostic and treatment facilities using open isotopes, including thyroid uptake scan, Gamma camera scan etc.

20. On receipt of the application under statute 19, the University shall send an inspection commission at least three months before the date of commencement of the First year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course examinations.
21. The Inspection Commission sent by the University shall,
 - (a) inspect the college regarding the teaching facilities provided for conduct of second year of the course.
 - (b) ensure whether all the facilities provided for conduct of first year BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course are continued to be provided.
 - (c) point out in its report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfilment of the conditions.
 - (d) specify as to the capability of the college to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months and submit the report to the university.

In case there is lacunae in the fulfilment of the conditions, the University may conduct such re-inspection on payment of re-inspection fee of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time and shall receive a final report from the inspection commission.

22. The University if fully satisfied as to the fulfilment of the conditions prescribed for affiliation of the second year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study, it shall direct the college / Medical Institution / Hospital to remit a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) towards the security deposit. The security deposit shall be invested in a Fixed deposit in a Nationalised Bank or Government Undertaking / Corporation jointly in the names of the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, and in the management of the college. The fixed deposit receipt shall be kept in the custody of the Registrar. The interest accrued on the Fixed Deposit shall be spent on the expenses connected with the conducting of the BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course and the applicant shall submit an utilization certificate in this regard in Form IV annexed to these statutes at the end of every academic year.
23. On remittance of the security deposit under Statute 22, and on payment of the affiliation fee of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards provisional affiliation fee for the second year of the course, the University shall grant provisional affiliation for second year BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study. The University may withdraw the provisional affiliation granted herein after giving three months notice stating the reasons therefor and after considering the explanation of the management of the college.
24. The provisional affiliation granted in statute 23 by the University shall be only for the Second Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study.
25. When six months period is left for the Second year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree Examination, the applicant shall apply to the University for provisional affiliation of the Third and Final Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study in Form III annexed to these statutes with a Demand Draft for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time, drawn in favour of the Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai towards the inspection fee and request the University to depute its Inspection Commission.

26. On receipt of the application under statute 25, the University shall send an inspection commission atleast three months before the date of commencement of the second year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree examinations.
27. The Inspection Commission sent by the University shall :-
 - (a) Inspect the college regarding the continuance of all the teaching faculties appointed for first and second year of the course.
 - (b) Ensure whether all the facilities provided for conduct of first and second year BMT(RD/RT/NM) degree course are continued to be provided.
 - (c) Point out in its report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfilment of the conditions.
 - (d) Specify as to the capability of the college to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months and submit the report to the University.

In case there are lacunae in the fulfilment of the conditions, the University may conduct such re-inspection on payment of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time and shall receive a final report from the inspection commission.

28. The University if fully satisfied as to the fulfilment of the conditions prescribed for affiliation of Third and Final Year B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) Degree course of study, it shall direct the college / Medical Institution / Hospital to remit a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards provisional affiliation fee for third and final year of the course. On payment of the affiliation fee of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards provisional affiliation fee for the Third and Final year of the course by the college / Medical Institution / Hospital, the University shall grant provisional affiliation for Third and Final year of BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study. The University may withdraw the provisional affiliation granted herein after giving three months notice stating the reasons therefor and after considering the explanation of the management of the college.
29. The University shall also be competent to send observers during examinations at their discretion.
30. The applicant shall send to the University every year a report regarding the service, academic and research activities of the college and also annual staff return.
31. (i) On completion of the course of study by the I batch of students and on their appearing for the University examination and after completion of 5 years period from the date of first affiliation of the said course in the said college / Medical Institution / Hospital by the University, the Management of the college / Medical Institution / Hospital may make an application in writing to the University for the grant of full affiliation of the B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study in Form V annexed to these statutes. The University shall after satisfying itself as to the performance of the college / Medical Institution / Hospital during the previous years and subject to the statutes and procedures as in force from time to time and after collecting full affiliation fee equivalent to five years provisional affiliation fee or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time in one lump sum and grant full affiliation to the B.M.T. (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study for a period of 5 (five) years only.

- (ii) On completion of 5 years of full affiliation granted to the said course in the said college / Medical Institution / Hospital the applicant shall make an application to the University in writing for grant of full affiliation of the course for a further period of 5 (five) years at a time along with a demand draft for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing council from time to time towards inspection fee.
 - (iii) On receipt of the application for full affiliation for a further period of 5 (five) years, the University may depute an inspection commission to verify the functioning of the said college / Medical Institution / Hospital during the previous five years and obtain a report from inspection commission. The University after detailed examination for the inspection report and after satisfying itself to the performance of the college during the previous five years may grant full affiliation for a further period of 5 years after collecting full affiliation fee equivalent to five years provisional affiliation fee or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time in one lump sum.
 - (iv) The above provisions will be followed for granting of full affiliation once in five years.
32. A provisional affiliation / Full affiliation granted by the University in respect of each year of the BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study is subject to the following conditions namely :-
- (a) The college / Medical Institution / Hospital shall conduct the course of study strictly in accordance with the course contents framed by the University and any modifications thereon suggested by the Boards of Studies concerned and the Standing Academic Board of the University from time to time.
 - (b) The University may inspect the college / Medical Institution / Hospital by sending an Inspector from the University, if the University so deems fit, after giving two weeks notice to the management of the college concerned. On receipt of report from the Inspector, the University may take any decision which in its opinion deems fit and necessary.
 - (c) The Governing Council shall have the power after due enquiry to withdraw full affiliation granted to a college, provided that before coming to such decision, the Governing Council shall inform the Governing Body of the College concerned of its findings after enquiry and shall allow it an opportunity of making such representation as it may deem fit and shall record its opinion on the representation so made.
33. The applicant may apply to this University for the increase in seats in BMT (RD/RT/NM) degree course of study up to a maximum of 15 (fifteen) seats only. Permission for increase of seats beyond 15 (fifteen) will not be considered.
34. It shall be competent for the Governing Council to entertain or decline to entertain, for reasons to be recorded in writing, the application received from the applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital for increase in the number of seats in the above subject to the ceiling specified in Statute 33. The University will review the facilities provided by the college and the performance of the college during the previous years and public interest covered at large, while entertaining the application for increase of seats.

35. No college shall apply to the University for increase in seats until the first batch of students have successfully completed the course and left the college and after obtaining the full affiliation of the course from the University.
36. The applicant college / Medical Institution / Hospital shall satisfy the University regarding the following norms as prescribed by the University in this regard from time to time while making application for increase in seats in Form VI annexed to these statutes.
- (i) Proportionate increase in the staff pattern
 - (ii) Proportionate increase in the equipment and laboratory facilities
 - (iii) Proportionate increase in the accommodation.
 - (iv) Expansion of library and
 - (v) It shall also obtain and enclose the prior permission of the Government of Tamil Nadu along with the application for such increase of seats.
37. On receipt of the application from the applicant for increase in seats, the University shall appoint an inspection commission to inspect the suitability of the facilities provided by the college for such increase in seats. A sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing council from time to time, shall be paid by the applicant college through a demand draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, towards the inspection fee.
38. The Inspection Commission sent by the University shall inspect the facilities available at the college for the proposed increase of seats and to submit the report to the University. The inspection commission shall also report the lacunae, if any, in the fulfilment of any of the conditions required to be fulfilled and also advise as to the capability of the college to rectify the lacunae within a period of two months. In case, there are lacunae in the fulfilment of the conditions, the University may conduct re-inspection on payment of a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing council from time to time towards re-inspection fee and shall receive a final report from the inspection commission.
39. On receipt of the final report of the above inspection commission, and if the report is found satisfactory, the University shall grant permission to the college concerned to admit students in the seats so increased.
40. The permission granted to the applicant college by the University under statute 39 is liable to be withdrawn if any of the norms prescribed in the statute 36 is violated. In case of such withdrawal, the permission shall be restored only when a satisfactory report is received by the University on an inspection that the norms prescribed in the statute 36 have been duly complied with.
41. No affiliated institution shall apply to the University for increase in seats in under graduate courses as well for starting of Post graduate courses simultaneously. Such applications can be made in different academic years.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42 of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R.Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987), the Governing Council of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R.Medical University, Chennai hereby makes the following amendments to the Affiliation of Medical Technology courses (BMT-RD/RT/NM) Degree course) Statutes of the Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R.Medical University, Chennai.

The amendments hereby made shall come into force on 18-8-2005 on which date they have received the assent of the Chancellor, communicated in Lr.No.3128/U2/2005, dt 18-8-2005.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Statutes,

- (1) the existing statute No.31 shall be deleted.
- (2) the following shall be inserted as statute 31.

31. Thereafter, three months before the closure of every academic year, the management of the college shall make an application in writing to the University for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for

conduct of the entire course of study during the next academic year along with the prescribed inspection fee and request the University to appoint an Inspection Commission to inspect the college for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study.

The University on receipt of such application shall appoint an Inspection Commission to inspect the college and to verify whether all the infrastructural facilities required for the conduct of the entire course of study are continued to be provided by the college. The Inspection Commission after inspecting the college shall submit a report to the University as to the continuance of all the required infrastructural facilities in the college for conduct of the entire course of study.

The University after detailed examination of the Inspection Report and if the University is fully satisfied as to the continuance of all the required infrastructural facilities for grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study, the University shall after collecting a sum of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees seventy five thousand only) or such amount as may be fixed by the Governing Council from time to time towards the fee for the grant of provisional affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study.

It shall be necessary for the management of the college to obtain the continuance of provisional affiliation to conduct the entire course of study, as stated above every year. The above provisions will be followed for granting Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for conduct of the entire course of study, every year.

It shall be competent for the University to withdraw the provisional affiliation granted herein for conduct of the entire course of study by giving 3 months notice stating the reasons therefor, to the management of the college and after considering the explanation submitted by the Management of the college.

AMENDMENTS

In the said statutes, the following provision shall be added after statute No.14:-

"14(A) The College/Institution shall be eligible to draw 50% of the total Security Deposit amount deposited with the University after completion of 10 years (from the date of payment of last installment in the case of deposit made in installments) with no adverse remarks.

14(B) If the College/Institution desires to withdraw 50% of the total Security Deposit, it shall make a written request to the University to that effect and the 50% of the Security Deposit will be refunded, provided the College/Institution to deposit remaining 50% of the Security Deposit in the Joint Names of the Registrar of the University and the Management of the College/Institution in a Nationalised Bank or Government Undertaking/Corporation.
