I am to inform you that the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Pharmacy Degree Courses held on 23.03.2022 was recommended by the Standing Academic Board, at the 61st meeting held on 21.04.2022. The following recommendations of the Standing Academic Board was approved by the Governing Council at the 291st meeting held on 09.06.2022.

RESOLUTION NO.1

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that the project carried out in VIII Semester B.Pharm shall be done in batches of minimum of 3 students to maximum of 5 students.

Within 15 days of commencement of VIII semester, the Principal shall inform the University of the title of the projects, the Department in which it is carried out and names of students undertaking the same.

Further resolved that the projects shall be carried out in all specializations namely Departments of Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry including Analysis, Pharmacology, Pharmacognosy and Pharmacy Practice. It is necessary that all the departments shall carry out the projects and not just one or two departments so that students are involved and exposed in applied research in various fields of Pharmaceutical Science.

During the end semester examination, the internal examiner shall be HOD/Professor of the Department concerned from the college. The external examiner shall be a senior faculty in the concerned department from another institution affiliated to the University. The number of days to conduct the end semester examination for the project shall depend on the number of projects in each specialization department. 30 minutes is recommended for each project evaluation and total of 12-16 projects shall be evaluated in a day.

The remuneration for project work can be given based on number of students like Practical examination.

RESOLUTION NO.2

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that more details to be collected with regard to Elective Subject of VIII Semester B.Pharm from Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council and need to be placed in the next Board of Studies for further action.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that the students must select one elective subject from each group given below:

A separate Internship Certificate for three months mentioning the department need to be obtained from the respective hospital.

The Standing Academic Board has resolved that to address to Pharmacy Council of India with regard to PCI letter dated 30-09-2020 guidelines for the lateral entry admission into Second Year B.Pharm Degree Course “Such D.Pharm holders admitted directly to B.Pharm 2nd Year shall pass those subjects of B.Pharm 1st year which are not covered under D.Pharm”. On reply from Pharmacy Council of India, the university will implement the guidelines from academic/admission year 2022-2023”.
