I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Course was held on 08.12.2014 and discussed various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in Ayurveda Course was resolved by the 49th meeting of the Standing Academic Board, held on 07.01.2015 and passed in the 233rd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 22.01.2014 which are detailed below:

1) THE UG SYLLABUS FOR 3rd AND 4th PROFESSIONAL YEAR OF AYURVEDACHARYA U.G. COURSE (BAMS) FRAMED BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN MEDICINE, NEW DELHI.

Resolved to follow the syllabus framed by the Central council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi for 3rd and 4th Year of Ayurvedacharya (BAMS) course for the candidates admitted from the academic Year 2012-2013 onwards.

2)APPOINTMENT OF EXAMINERS (UG) FOR THEORY AND PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

It was resolved to fix the following criteria for appointment of examiners for BAMS Course.

Internal Examiners : Teaching faculty with Post Graduate qualification having minimum three years of experience.

External Examiners: Teaching faculty with Post Graduate qualification having minimum five years of experience.

For paper valuation : Teaching faculty with Post Graduate qualification having minimum five years of experience.

It was resolved to write a letter to the Central Council of Indian Medicine with regard to the appointment of Examiners as there is scarcity of examiners with eight years of teaching experience in the concerned subject after Post Graduation.

3)The students of 2010-2011 batch should have appeared for their II Professional Examination in August 2013. But due to multiple court adjournments and court holidays, the court could permit them to appear for examinations only in February 2014. Requested the university to permit the candidates to appear for their final Examination in February 2015.

It was resolved that the candidates should complete prescribed period of study (18 months) to appear for III Professional Examination as per the Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and the candidates are eligible to appear for Examinations in August 2015 only.

In the final Professional BAMS Examination, the Paper Kayachikitsa IV shall be renamed as Panchakarma as per the existing CCIM regulations. The above change shall be implemented from February 2015 Examination Session onwards for students who are admitted in academic year 2010-2011. .

The name of the paper will be continued as Kayachikitsa IV for the existing arrear candidates.

4) ISSUE OF MIGRATION & TRANSCRIPT CERTIFICATES :

It was resolved to issue Migration and Transcript certificates to the candidates who have paid the fees along with their examination fees at the earliest and it was decided to make it as optional for payment towards Migration Certificates . Further it was resolved to delegate the power to the respective colleges to issue Transcript Certificates to their students and the University will issue only the consolidated mark statement with existing fee structure.

It was further resolved to implement the above from the academic year 2015-16 admission onwards.

5) FEE STRUCTURE AND THE MAXIMUM DURATION TO BE ALLOWED BEYOND THE DOUBLE THE DURATION OF STUDY IN UNDER GRADUATE / POST GRADUATE COURSES.

It was resolved to refer the issue to the Examination Reforms Committee to fix the fee on a year basis for candidates who have not completed the course of study within double the duration and applying beyond the period of double the duration.

It was further resolved to permit the candidates who have crossed Double the duration in their course of study to appear for the examinations after collecting the prescribed fees. The students should follow the existing scheme while appearing for examination.

Further, it was resolved to write a letter to the respective Central Councils of the concerned courses for clarification about the implementation of double the duration scheme.

6)REGARDING COMPULSORY IMPLEMENTATION OF SIX MONTH CORE MODULE SYLLABUS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES FOR ALL UNDERGRADUATE COURSESAS REQUESTED BY THE SECRETARY OF UNIVERSITY GRANT COMMISSION.

Resolved to address the respective regulatory authorities regarding the compulsory implementation of six months core module syllabus on Environmental Studies for all under graduate courses.

7) THE ERRORS OCCURED IN EVALUATION OF THEORY PAPERS AT THE UNIVERSITY

Resolved to implement the following corrective/punitive measures on the evaluators of theory papers for effective evaluation of answer sheets of the candidates. It is further resolved to circulate this to all the affiliated institutions and to place in the University website under "Corrective Measures for Paper Evaluators".

S.No	Evaluation error Committed	Penalty suggested
1	Error in evaluation for the first time	The evaluation remuneration for that particular session shall be forfeited
2	Error in evaluation for the second time	Evaluation remuneration for the session shall be forfeited and the evaluator is debarred for three subsequent examination sessions including UG and PG
3	Error in evaluation for the third time	The evaluator will forfeit the remuneration for that particular examination session and will be permanently debarred from the evaluation process of this university

This will be implemented from February 2015 examination onwards.

8) ENTRY OF INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MARKS AND THE ATTENDANCE BY THE INSTITUTIONS.

It was resolved that the on-line entry of the IA & Practical marks once entered and submitted will not be corrected from August 2015 exam session. However, the Principals / Head of the Institutions can be called for a session for updating the same.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of the students concerned.
