I am to inform that the Meeting of the Board of Studies in
Homoeopathy Course was held on 24.06.2013 and discussed
various academic matters. The decisions of the Board of Studies in
Homoeopathy Course was resolved by the 46th meeting of the
Standing Academic Board, held on 17.07.2013 and passed in the
222nd Meeting of the Governing Council held on 13.8.2013 which
are detailed below:

1) THE MANDATORY CREDIT POINTS FOR CRRIs AND P.G CANDIDATES OF AYUSH MEDICAL DEGREE COURSES.

The standing Academic Board has resolved to approve the introduction of CME credit points for CRRIs and Post Graduate candidates as requested by the Commissioner of Indian Medicine.

Further it was resolved, that the CRRi candidates and Post Graduates should attend atleast one Continuing Medical Education Programme conducted by the Central / State Council of Homoeopathy or by the affiliated Homoeopathy Institutions. Ten points may be awarded to the CRRIs and Thirty points to the Post Graduates for the participation of one CME programme.

2) THE PATTERN OF UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION FROM FEBRUARY 2013 AS PER THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF HOMOEOPATHY

Resolved to ratify the action of having followed the norms of the Central Council of Homoeopathy for the University Examination for February 2013 Examination.

It was resolved the B.H.M.S. Examination will be conducted as per the norms of the Central Council of Homoeopathy from August 2013 session onwards and to continue the existing pattern following the norms of the Central council of Homoeopathy for the ensuing Examinations also.

The Internal Assessment and attendance requirement be followed as per the norms of the Central Council of Homoeopathy.

3) THE AMENDED REGULATIONS BASED ON THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF HOMOEOPATHY REGULATIONS 2013.

It was resolved that the Amended Regulations for M.D (Homoeopathy) is approved based on the Central Council of Homoeopathy Regulations 2012 with the following modifications

Sub –clause (ii) under Sl. No. 23 should be read as follows:

(ii) The Viva-Voce /Practical Examinations in each subject to be held by not less than three examiners together out of which one shall be the Supervisor (Guide).

Sub –clause (ii) under Sl. No. 27 should be read as follows:

(ii) Practical / Clinical Examination including Viva-voce in the subject of speciality to test the candidate's acumen and his ability and working knowledge in the practice of the specialty and there shall be three Examiners together including one supervisor (Guide) in the subject for Examining the candidate provided that all the three Examiners shall jointly assess the knowledge of the candidate for recommending the result to the University as passed or failed.

Sub –clause (i) under Sl. No. 33 should be read as follows:

(i) The qualifications for the Examiners shall be the same as of the guides.

Modified M.D(Homoeopathy) Central Council of Homoeopathy Regulation is annexed.

**(4) THE DISSERTATION FORMAT FOR M.DHOMOEOPATHY
FORWARDED BY THE CENTRAL COUNCIL OF
HOMOEOPATHY.**

It was approved that the Protocol / Proforma of the dissertation for M.D. (Homoeopathy) forwarded by the Central Council Homoeopathy (enclosed Annexure – II)

**5) TO PRESCRIBE CERTAIN GUIDELINES FOR
CHANGE OF NAME / DATE OF BIRTH IN THE
MARK STATEMENTS/ CERTIFICATES PRIOR TO
ISSUE OF DEGREE CERTIFICATES.**

Resolved that the following guidelines for change of name in the Degree Certificates be implemented from **the 25th Convocation onwards.**

- (i) No change/correction in the name shall be made after issue of Degree Certificate. However, on verification of the gazette notification, a letter shall be issued to the effect.
- (ii) Applications for name corrections should reach the University within a month's time from the date of issue of Provisional Pass Certificate.
- (iii) Request for correction/Change in name / date of birth shall be forwarded by the Head of the College along with attested photostat copies of:-
 - i. Application for admission of the candidate to the School or Birth Certificate;

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- ii. Portion of the page of admission and withdrawal register where entry in

name/date of birth has been made.

- iii. The Transfer Certificate of the School/College submitted at the time of admission.

**6) TO MAKE CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS IN THE
DOUBLE THE DURATION SCHEME – REG.**

Resolved that the Regulations for readmission under Double the Duration scheme introduced in the last academic year 2012-2013 as one time measure, enabling the candidates to re-join their respective course of study be extended for this academic year i.e. 2013-14 alone.

Candidates admitted under the Double the Duration Scheme during the academic year 2012-13 and not completed their course even under the scheme, shall not be permitted to apply for second time

All Post Graduate and Under Graduate candidates applying under Double the Duration Scheme during the academic year 2013-14 who had completed their course but not passed their examinations be given one year grace period alone [two continuous sessions of Examination] to complete their respective course of study.

7) TO PRESCRIBE GUIDELINES FOR THE RESUBMISSION OF THE DISSERTATIONS IN THE CASE OF "NOT APPROVED" CANDIDATES UNIFORMLY FOR ALL PG DEGREE COURSES IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, AYUSH AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES.

Resolved that, the candidates should submit their dissertations three months before appearing for their Final year Examination. If the dissertation is "NOT APPROVED", the candidates should resubmit the dissertation within six months. Till the dissertation is approved (within the period of Double the duration of the course) the Final year results will not be published.

In the case of Post Graduate study where there is no theory Examinations at the end of 2nd year of study like M. Pharmacy and the candidates should submit only the dissertation for evaluation and could not submit the same within the prescribed period shall apply to the University for permission to submit the same within a period of one year from the date of completion of the 2nd year period of study. Such candidates who have not submitted the dissertation within the extended period permitted by the University shall apply for readmission of the study and obtain necessary permission from the University for rejoining the course from the beginning of the 1st year of study and shall pass all the prescribed theory Examinations of the 1st year.

I am to request that the decision of the Standing Academic Board as mentioned above may be communicated to all the Professors and Heads of Departments for information and further follow up action in the regard. I am also to request that a copy of this letter may be displayed on the Notice Board of the College / Hostel for information of

the students concerned.
