The Meeting of the Board of Studies in Pharmacy was held on 17-05-11 and recommended various matters in the Curriculum, Regulation etc., The above recommendation of the Board of Studies in Pharmacy were approved in the 41st meeting of the Standing Academic Board held on 14-06-2011 are hereby communicated to take necessary further follow up thereon.

I. THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE TO FRAME GUIDELINES FOR MIGRATION/TRANSFER OF DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES FROM ONE INSTITUTION TO ANOTHER INSTITUTION.

Resolved to approve the guidelines framed by the Expert Committee with regard to Migration / Transfer of Dental, Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy and Allied Health Science course candidates from one Institution to another Institution.
The above resolution will come into effect from 1st July 2011 onwards.

II. THE ACTION TAKEN FOR HAVING INTRODUCED TWO ACADEMIC BATCHES IN A YEAR AND TWO CUT-OFF DATES FOR M.Sc.(N), M.PHARMACY, M.P.T. COURSES AND POST GRADUATE ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES WHICH COMES UNDER THE PURVIEW OF SELECTION COMMITTEE FOR SELECTION IN THE SAME ACADEMIC YEAR

Resolved to record the acceptance for the action taken for having introduced two academic batches and two cut-off dates for M.Sc.(N), M.Pharmacy, M.P.T., and P.G. Allied Health Science courses which comes under the purview of selection committee for selection in the same academic year with a condition that the admission should not be exceeded the original sanctioned intake of the institution per year, at any cost.

III. THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE EXPERT COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED FOR MERGING OF ALL REGULATIONS INTO SINGLE REGULATION.

Resolved that the following subjects in respect of 2003 – 2004 regulations (U.G) will continue till August 2011 due to the fact that the student can complete the course in double duration (eight years) as permitted by the university.

The following subjects in the respective year will continue as before :

1.Pharmaceutical Physical Chemistry	- First Year
2.Mathematics including Bio-statistics	- First Year
3.Preparative Pharmacy including history of pharmacy	- Second Year
4.Pharmaceutical administration and industrial business management	- Second Year
5.Pharmacy Practice	- Second Year
6.Chemistry of synthetic drugs	- Third Year
7.Pharmacology and Toxicology	- Third Year
8.Forensic pharmacy	- Third Year
9.Chemistry of natural products	- Fourth Year

The subject Formulative & Industrial pharmacy is the same as Formulative pharmacy & Bio-pharmaceutics. Hence the students of 2003-2004 regulations may be permitted to write Formulative pharmacy & Bio-pharmaceutics instead of Formulative & Industrial pharmacy. All other subjects of the 2003 – 2004 regulation will be brought under the regulation 2009-2010.

In respect of students who come under 2004 – 2005, 2006-2007 (UG Course) regulation will write based on the regulations 2009 – 2010 due to identical syllabus.

The candidates of all Post Graduate courses of 2006 – 2007 regulation will be brought under the new regulation ie. 2010 – 2011.

It is further resolved that with regard to UG Pharmacy course the subject Forensic Pharmacy and Pharmacy Business Management is same as Pharmaceutical Jurisprudence and Pharmacy Business Management. Hence the students of 2004 – 2005 regulation may be permitted to write Pharmaceutical Jurisprudence and Pharmacy Business Management instead of Forensic Pharmacy and Pharmacy Business Management.

The above resolution will come into force from August 2011 Examination onwards.

IV. Further, in the 41st meeting of the Standing Academic Board it was resolved to recommend the decision of the Board of Studies in Pharmacy held on 17.05.2011 and are as follows:

- (1) TO INFORM ABOUT THE CHANGE OF NOMENCLATURE OF B.PHARMACY AND M.PHARMACY TO B.PHARM AND M.PHARM AS SUGGESTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF MEDICAL EDUCATION, CHENNAI.

It was unanimously resolved by the members to adopt the change of nomenclature of abbreviated degree of B.Pharmacy & M. Pharmacy to B.Pharm and M.Pharm in future correspondence.

- (2) TO INFORM THE BOARD OF STUDIES IN NURSING, PHARMACY, PHYSIOTHERAPY, PARA-PROFESSIONAL COURSES AND THE NEWLY STARTED ALLIED HEALTH COURSES REGARDING THE REVISED SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND UNIFORM QUESTION PAPER PATTERN FOR U.G. AND P.G. COURSES.
