In the reference cited, Competency Based Medical Education (CBME) Regulation, 2024 dated 12.09.2024 was published by National Medical Commission, New Delhi for MBBS Degree course.

All are hereby informed to follow the Regulations of National Medical Commission, New Delhi.

In continuation to the above, the University has made some of the following recommendations based on the above guidelines, which is to be followed strictly

1. Foundation Course attendance to be documented and kept in concerned Phase I departments.
2. Family Adoption Programme attendance of Phase I and Phase II to be maintained by Community Medicine Department to decide eligibility to appear for the Community Medicine Examination at the end of Phase III Part I.

3. Quarterly students' attendance to be sent to University and final cumulative attendance at the end of each Phase.

4. Remedial Measures to be followed as per NMC, CBME 2024 Guidelines.

5. Academic Record and Assessment Record based on CBME 2024 competencies to be released from University.

6. Academic Record and Assessment Record for Phase II & III (2023 batch) to be released from University.

7. A Uniform Time Table for 2024 Batch will be prepared by the University and circulated to the affiliated institutions.

8. Scheme for Theory Examination to be formulated as

a) MCQ-20 (20x 1= 20 Marks). Out of 20 MCQs, 5 will be case scenario based.

b) Essay 1 (1 x 10 Marks)

c) Reasoning out short notes 2 (2 x 5 marks)

d) Short Notes 10 (10 X 6 Marks) (Out of 10 questions, 1 should be from AETCOM and 4 should be from Applied aspects)

9. Mentor – Mentee Allotment to be done during Foundation Course itself. All the Faculty of the respective institutions should be included as per NMC norms.

10. Parent – Teacher Meeting to be conducted Phase wise atleast once during each Phase.

I request you to kindly circulate the above information to all the Professors and Head of the Departments concerned for further follow up action in this regard.
